- Federated Farmers of New Zealand Inc (Southland) has an interest in all of the appeal, in particular in relation to:

## Physiographic Policies

- Federated Farmers submitted and further submitted on Physiographic Zone Policies 4 to 12.
- We agree with the appellant that the purpose of the policies must be consistent with the overall objective of 'holding the line' prior to limitsetting.
- We retain an active interest in any appeals on these policies as any movement in wording will have a considerable impact on our members.

## Policy 42 – Consideration of Water Permit applications

- Federated Farmers opposed the notified rule.
- We did not consider it was appropriate to reduce the allocation within an
  existing permit where the catchment was over-allocated, provided the permit
  was lawfully established, and the rate and volume of the take was either the
  same or less than the lawfully established rate and volume.
- We retain and active interest in any appeals on this Policy, given the potential impact on our members.
