- This memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of Waihopai Rūnaka, Hokonui Rūnaka, Te Rūnanga o Awarua, Te Rūnanga o Oraka Aparima, and Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu (collectively Ngā Rūnanga).
- 2. The Topic B, Tranche 1 'all of parties' hearing is scheduled to commence on Monday 14 March 2022. Based on the hearing schedule filed by counsel for Environment Southland on 1 March 2022, the 'all of parties' hearing is expected to take five days.
