

- 2 These details on this submission are about how it afficts our lives living here and coping with all of this nonsense coming out of Wellington with our farming operation.
- 3 Not in Support of this application. Because there are no Ratepayers on this Application from the Waituna Creek.
- 4a Our Property Rights of freehold Ratepayers are being eroded. We are of Maori decent from the Lee's of Rakiura Stewart Island from 1830s. The McCrosties and Annabell Crack are also Maori decent. There has been no contact from iwi as to how this is afflicting us with the lack of openings and the higher water levels of the Lagoon.
- 4b Lake Waituna is a feeding habitat for a lot of wading birds. This increase in water levels is destroying a lot of food for these Birds. As it is too deep now to get sunlight down to the Plants which now are dying from being too deep underwater.
- 4c Access to Forgertys Pine tree Block is Flooded at times with trees uprooted from flooding ground too soft with the higher water levels. D.O.C claim the birdlife can go elsewhere this is leading to more geese, swans, ducks spreading Salmonella to local farms. This is a Ramson Site which has been opened regularly for 120 years. I bet the wading birds would Squaw D.O.C can go find a new home

4d There are too many Shiney ArGe's getting
Salarys and making wrong decision's about
this Ramsor site that degradation is
happening. Dead fish and eels. Dying plants
Toxic algae deadly to dogs etc. Sheding from
Tanon'S in Waituna Lagoon. The Lagoon needs
opened with Regularity to flush Clean and for
yearly fish passage
