Why I wish Environment Southland to make this decision	The flood levels to remain at 2.0 meters, as it has been for the last active Resource Consent, and prior to this for over 80 years. If the new Resource Consent is approved, all farm land effected by the new level of 2.5, must be brought by the applicants at market rates. The lagoon must be opened to the sea at least once every two years for allowing fish passage to the lagoon.
