This submission is on behalf of the seven members of our hunting camp on the southern end of the wee lake at Waituna Lagoon.

While these seven members are related in some way, we had our beginning at Waituna in 1907.

While our visits in the main have been related to harvesting game birds or trout, the need to visit places like Waituna gives much needed respite from our everyday lives.

There is no doubt that this wonderful area gives to us a much-needed spiritual experience and well-being.

It has been extremely disappointing on the area used as a political football in recent times

We do not agree to many of the proposals in this consent application and believe that only a temporary fiveyear consent be given with prove that the needs of the lagoon are being met. It would be too easy to just continue with the consent time frame and not have any positive outcomes.

We are not convinced that the holding of water levels desired in the application will have the results wanted and in fact may create more problems instead.

This season's game bird hunting was greatly affected by the lagoons high water levels, as with the bridge and road closed for a long period, access was totally impossible by vehicle and no access for launching boats on the northern side of the bridge.

We therefore ask that the following changes be made to the application....

- 1. That a consent only be issued for five years.
- 2. That the water levels be 2.3m for the summer period and 2.2 for the winter period.
- 3. On both of these levels its required that they are held for seven days before considering opening the lagoon to the sea.

4. That when these water levels are met the lagoon WILL be opened to the sea as soon as practical.
